

**Howard County Fair  
Fine Arts and Photographs  
Department Rules**

1. A limit of 5 paintings or photographs per division. These can be in different classes or all in one.
2. Painting and photographs can be any subject or style as long as they are the original work of the exhibitor.
3. All paintings and photographs must be framed and ready for hanging. We require a wire for hanging.
4. Paintings and photographs must not have received an award in a showing at this fair. They must have been completed within the last 2 years.
5. Entries cannot be removed until after 10:00 P.M. Saturday night or between 1:00 to 3:00 P.M. Sunday.
6. Work must be original. Reproduction (copy) of any work of art, photo, or magazine pictures will not be permitted. You may be asked for your drawing draft if your entry is questionable.
7. Judging will be done by a qualified judge. His/her decision will be final. The judge has the authority to combine classes or mediums, if necessary, under any circumstances.
8. Paintings and photographs must not exceed 60" overall height or width. Photographs must be at least 8" x 10".
9. Any entry unacceptable to the Rules Committee will not be displayed.
10. We appreciate your entries and will do all we can to ensure they are properly taken care of. However, we cannot be responsible for loss or damage.
11. Awards: First, Second, and Third, and Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded in each class. There will be 1 Grand Champion and 1 Reserve Champion in each division. A plaque will be awarded to the work selected as Best in Show and People's Choice. Cash prizes will be awarded when available.
12. You may offer your entries for sale. You must leave a business card with price and your contact information. Buyers will be required to contact you personally. Howard County Fair will not be responsible for collecting money.
